1. Application Submission

- ✓ Complete the online form.
- ✓ Upload documents: license, academic catalog, faculty CVs, sample syllabi.

2. Preliminary Review

✓ Check for completeness and eligibility.

3. BDAAT™ Assessment

✓ Academic review committee evaluates the institution.

4. Virtual Audit (If Required)

✓ Online interview or virtual campus tour.

5. Final Report

✓ Includes total score, strengths, and suggestions.

6. Approval & Accreditation

✓ If score \geq 75%, digital certificate and AAITM badge are issued.

7. Annual Review & Renewal

- ✓ Submit annual academic performance report.
- ✓ Renewal fees apply.

- Legal registration and academic license.
- Accreditation recognition (national/international).
- Organizational chart.
- Academic curriculum.
- Faculty profiles.
- Student feedback results.
- Research & innovation activities.
- Quality assurance or academic governance manual.
