# 1) Resources at a Glance

- **Credential Validity:** 3 years from the date of certification issuance.
- Renewal Options:
  - 1. Earn 60 PDCs through BDA-approved Professional Development Providers (PDPs).
  - 2. Recertify by Examination (available only in the final year of your 3-year cycle).
- Where to Renew: BDA Certification Portal (submit PDCs or register for exam).
- Fees: €150 standard; €200 late (within 60-day grace).
- Carryover: Any PDCs you earn beyond 60 in your current cycle carry forward to your next cycle.
- **Status if not renewed:** Credential becomes Expired after the cycle (plus any grace period) if no renewal is completed.

# 2) Why Recertify?


Business development is dynamic—markets, technologies, and partnership models evolve constantly. Recertification ensures BDA-certified professionals remain aligned to the BDA Body of Competency & Knowledge (BDA BoCK™) and uphold globally recognized standards across:

### **Behavioral Competencies (45%)**:

- Strategic Leadership
- Effective Communication
- Business Acumen
- Emotional intelligence
- Critical Thinking & Problem solving
- Consultative Mindset
- Negotiation & Relationship Management

## **Knowledge-Based Competencies (55%):**

- Growth & Expansion Strategies
- Market & Competitive Analysis
- Innovation in Business Development
- Business Project Management
- Financial & Pricing Models
- Marketing & Sales Strategies
- Legal & Compliance in BD



The BDA Body of Competencies and Knowledge® (BDA BoCK™) is the foundation of the BDA certification program. The BDA BoCK™ describes the behavioral and technical competencies BD practitioners need for effective business growth.

# 3) Recertification Requirements

To maintain an Active credential, you must complete one of the following within your 3-year cycle:

#### Option A — PDCs Route

- Earn 60 PDCs through BDA-approved PDP™ providers (courses, workshops, webinars, or blended formats delivered by partners in your region or globally).
- Record all PDCs in the BDA Certification Portal before your credential expiration.

## **Option B — Examination Route**

- Sit for (and pass) the BDA certification exam during the final year of your 3-year cycle.
- Standard exam fees apply; scheduling is completed via the BDA Certification Portal.

You may complete requirements early. Once approved, your credential is renewed for a new 3-year cycle starting on the day after your current cycle ends.



# 4) Recertifying with Professional Development Credits (PDCs)

## 4.1 What qualifies for PDCs?

Only activities delivered by BDA-approved Professional Development Providers (PDPs) qualify. Typical formats include:

- Instructor-led courses (in-person or live online)
- Workshops & seminars
- Webinars and short programs aligned to BDA BoCK™
- Blended learning offered by a PDP.

PDCs must be aligned to the BDA BoCK™ competencies. Your completion proof must reflect the Program Name, PDP Provider Name, Program ID, completion date, and hours/PDCs awarded.

#### 4.2 Earning pattern & pacing

- You can earn PDCs at any time throughout your 3-year cycle.
- You can mix multiple PDP programs—local or global—so long as they are **BDA-approved** and you record them in the portal.

#### 4.3 Documentation you should retain

- Certificate of completion (or transcript/attendance letter)
- Program description/syllabus (if requested for verification)
- Program ID and PDP name as listed by BDA



# 5) Recertification by Examination

#### **5.1 Eligibility**

- Available only in the final year of your 3-year cycle.
- Recommended for candidates who prefer a comprehensive reassessment based on the BoCK™.

#### 5.2 Registration & Scheduling

- Register for the exam via the BDA Certification Portal.
- Pay the standard exam fee.
- When the official exam windows open, you will select your date/time and complete your exam.

#### 5.3 Outcome

- Passing the exam renews your credential for a new 3-year cycle.
- If you do not pass before your expiration (or grace window), your credential will expire and you must meet reinstatement requirements (retake exam as a new candidate).

# 6) Recording and Tracking Your PDCs

#### 6.1 How to add a PDC entry

- 1. Log in to the BDA Certification Portal.
- 2. Go to My PDCs  $\rightarrow$  Add PDC.
- 3. Enter the Program Name, PDP Provider Name, and Program ID.
- 4. Upload your proof of completion (PDF/JPG/PNG).
- 5. Submit.

#### 6.2 Statuses you will see

- Pending: Submitted and awaiting verification.
- Approved: Counted toward your 60-PDC requirement.
- Rejected: Not eligible (you'll see the reason; you may resubmit with corrections).

#### **6.3 Tracking your progress**

#### Your dashboard shows:

- Total Approved PDCs this cycle
- Submissions Pending
- Days Remaining in your cycle

# 7) Carryover Credits

- If you exceed 60 PDCs in your current 3-year cycle, the surplus PDCs carry forward automatically to your next cycle after your renewal is processed.
- Carryover appears on your portal dashboard at the start of the new cycle.

Tip: You don't have to "time" your learning, continue your development; the portal will carry forward any surplus once your renewal is approved.

# 8) Recertification Processing Fees

#### **Important:**

- Payment is completed inside the BDA Certification Portal.
- If you do not complete renewal within the 60-day grace period, your credential becomes Expired and you must meet reinstatement requirements (typically, retake the exam).

# 9) Verification & Audit Process

To protect the integrity of BDA credentials, submissions may be audited:

- You may be selected randomly or due to a data inconsistency.
- If audited, you'll be asked to provide documentation supporting each PDC (completion certificate, attendance record, or confirmation from the PDP provider).
- Ineligible or unverifiable activities will be removed from your record. If removal drops you below 60 PDCs, you must submit additional qualifying credits or pursue the exam route (if eligible).

**Ethics & Accuracy:** Submitting inaccurate information or falsifying documents may result in denial of renewal or disciplinary action per BDA policies.

# 10) Special Circumstances (Extensions & Status)

#### **10.1 Grace Period (Late Renewal)**

- You have 60 days after your expiration date to complete renewal at the €200 late fee.
- During the grace period, your credential is considered Lapsed Pending Renewal.

## **10.2 Expired Status**

- If you do not renew within the grace period, your credential status changes to Expired.
- To regain active status, you will need to retake and pass the certification exam according to current requirements.

## **10.3 Extensions for Hardship**

- If you face exceptional circumstances (e.g., medical leave, force majeure), you may submit an Extension Request through the portal.
- Requests are reviewed by the BDA Certification Committee. Decisions and any temporary accommodations will be communicated in writing.







# 11) BDA Recertification Provider Program (PDP™)

BDA-PDP™ accredits organizations to deliver professional development activities that award BDA-recognized PDCs. Each approved PDP:

- Publishes programs aligned to BDA BoCK™ competencies.
- Provides learners with a Program ID and completion documentation.
- May be listed on BDA platforms for global visibility.

#### For Candidates:

- Choose programs from BDA-approved PDPs in your region or online.
- Record the Program Name, PDP Partner, Program ID in the BDA Certification Portal.
- Keep your completion certificate for verification.
